RED WINES BY THE GLASS

House Red (Australia)

A sustainable farmed organic favorite from David's homeland. **glass 5.75**

Mount Linden Cabernet (California)

Aromas of berries, cocoa & anise, accented with a potpourri of spices. **glass 7.00 bottle 26.00**

M. Chapoutier Belleruche

Cotes-du-Rhone (France)

Smooth with flavors of red and black fruits followed by licorice, pepper, and vanilla. Supple tannins give this French gem a pleasant balance. **glass 7.50 bottle 28.00**

Mount Linden Syrah (California)

Barrel aged with rich flavors of raspberry & plum accented by hints of cream & chocolate.

Casa Solar Tempranillo (Spain)

Aromas of blackberries surrounded by cherry fruit flavors. Light-bodied, soft round mouthfeel with a nice balanced finish. Classic Spanish.

Tangley Oaks Merlot (Napa Valley)

Red berry & plum flavors along with notes of espresso & cassis, firm tannins and a lingering finish. **glass 9.00 bottle 34.00**

McManis Petite Sirah (California)

A full bodied Petite Sirah loaded with jammy black and purple fruit aromas. This wine is soft and round on the palette. **glass 8.50 bottle 32.00**

Callia Malbec (Argentina)

Notes of spices and red fruits, good structure, fresh and elegant mouthfeel. Well-balanced with a long intense finish. **glass 7.75 bottle 29.00**

DeLoach Pinot Noir (California)

Barrel-to-Barrel.....straight from the vineyard's barrel to ours on the bar. Burgundian style with cherry, mint & leather on the nose with additional textures & mouthfeel for a true "from the barrel" experience. **glass 8.00**

BY THE BOTTLE

Ridge 3 Valleys Blend (California)

A Zinfandel based blend from Alexander, Russian River, and Dry Creek Valleys. Black fruits dominate, with a bright blast of peppery spice. **44.00**

Archery Summit Premier

Cuvee Pinot Noir (Oregon)

Medium-bodied with a lush nose of sweet cassis, boysenberry, and cherry cola leading to flavors of red cherry, pomegranate, and earthy notes. Firm and silky tannins. An amazing Pinot. **70.00**

d'Arenberg 'The Footbolt' Shiraz (Australia)

Deep red raspberry and purple mulberry aromas, framed by leathery spice and a long rolling finish. It's like taking an already great Shiraz and turning up the bass and treble. **39.00**

Laurona Montsant (Spain)

A wine of remarkable depth and smoothness, it's composed mostly of Grenache and Carignane. This is from Montsant, an area just outside the well known (and expensive) region of Priorat, in far Northeastern Spain. **40.00**

Conti Contini Sangiovese (Italy)

Clean & lively with a bright nose of red fruit & floral bits augmented with smoke & spice. **30.00**

Seghesio Omaggio (Sonoma)

This homage to Super Tuscans, Omaggio is a tribute to Peter Seghesio's grandparents who planted their first grapes in 1895. Dark ruby red color, nose of black fruit, sour cherry, black currant & plum with scents of pine on the palate, balanced & elegant. Cheers! to Peter Seghesio & family. **85.00**

WHITE BY THE GLASS

House White (Australia)

Yalumba Viognier (Australia)

Stone fruits (apricot, peach) abound in this expressive and balanced gem from South Australia. **glass 7.25 bottle 27.00**

Ranga-Ranga Sauvignon Blanc (New Zealand)

Clear & vibrant. Intensely flavored with a zest of lime, juicy passion fruit, lightly grassy and a hint of wild herbs. A perfect example of a New Zealand Sauvignon Blanc.

Wolf Riesling (Germany)

Pflaz Region gem with fresh notes of crunchy grape, white peach & juicy pear. Finely tuned mineral and light mouthfeel. A pure expression of a dry-styled Riesling. **glass 7.50 bottle 28.00**

Cuvaison Chardonnay (Carneros)

Aromas of orange, acacia blossoms & citrus fruits on the nose with pear, apricot, vanilla & allspice with a hint of clove on the finish. Slightly oaked boasting balanced richness & minerality.

Kettmeir Pinot Grigio (Italy)

Santa Margherita's cousin from across the valley. This Italian gem is invitingly dry & crisp with a fruity taste, not sweet though, sharp acidity that lingers thru the finish. **glass 7.75 bottle 29.00**

BY THE BOTTLE

Marques De Irun Rueda (Spain)

Bold & bright, this Rueda Verdejo shines like the sun. An entrancing, utterly pleasing nose offers scents of apricot, lemon oil, sesame & spring sea breeze. Crisp & refreshing on the palate, but with balanced weight - it's marvelous. **39.00**

Valley of the Moon Pinot Blanc (Sonoma)

A traditional Alsatian-style wine. Crisp and fresh with aromas of lime zest and pear followed by flavors of papaya and cantaloupe. **30.00**

Ferrari-Carano Fume Blanc (Sonoma)

Zesty flavors & aromas of orange blossom, grapefruit & lemon mingle with subtle mineral notes, complemented by a lingering finish of guava & pineapple. Crisp, fresh, balanced, but complex. **40.00**

SPARKLING WINE

Cristalino Brut (Spain)

Straw color, smooth and fresh aromas. Fine and fruity palate with a dry aftertaste. Clean, dry & crisp with citrus and apple flavors. **glass 5.95 bottle 23.00**
